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

## ◆ How to install E-Con driver


You must install E-CON driver first before using E-CON

E-CON driver will be copied automatically while you install EISC Studio3.


After you have installed EISC Studio3, go to '**C:\Program Files\ADChips\EISC Studio 3\econ\driver**'



Run UsbDriverTool.exe and connect E-Con to computer.



Click mouse right button on E-Con and click Install ECon JTAG/SWD.  
Install each in the same way.



When the driver is installed, you can see that it has been changed to a E-Con JTAG/SWD A / B as follow.
